

LEVYING SALES AND USE TAX

ORDINANCE NO. 188

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF A 1% SALES AND USE TAX WITH THE CITY OF CHERRY VALLEY, ARKANSAS, TO BE DIVIDED EQUALLY FOR THE CITY PARK COMPLEX AND CITY GENERAL FUND; PRESCRIBING OTHER MATTERS PERTAINING THERETO;

WHEREAS, the City Council of Cherry Valley, Arkansas (the " City'), has determined that there is a great need for immediate improvement of general municipal services and the city park complex for a source of revenue to finance such services for a period of 5 years; and

WHEREAS, Title 26, Chapter 75, Subchapter 2 for Subchapter 3 in the second authority is to be used) of the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated (the Authorizing Legislation) provides for a levy of a one percent (1%) city wide sales and use tax.

NOW, THEREFORE, BEIT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY VALLEY, ARKANSAS.

SECTION 1

Under the authority of the Authorizing Legislation, there is hereby levied a one percent (1%) Tax on the Gross Receipts from the sale at retail within the City of all items which are subject to the Arkansas Gross Receipts Act of 1941, as amended (Ark. Code Ann§ 26- 52- 101, et seq.) and the imposition of the excise(or use) tax on the storage, use, distribution or consumption within the City of tangible personal property subject to Arkansas Compensating Tax Act of 1949, as amended (Ark. Code Ann. § 26- 53- 101, et set). at a rate of one percent (1%) of the sale price of the property or, in the case of leases or rentals, of the lease or rental price (collectively, the 'Sales and Use Tax').

SECTION 2

That all ordinances and parts thereof in conflict here within are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3



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
