ORDINANCE NO. 136

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING PLACES FOR THE POSTING OF ORDINANCES; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND PRESCRIBING OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO.

WHEREAS, no newspaper is published in the City of Cherry Valley, Arkansas (the "Municipality"); and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate, pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated §14-55-206, that the Municipality designate five of the most public places in the Municipality for posting of notice of the adoption of ordinances of the Municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Cherry Valley, Arkansas:

<u>Section 1</u>: The following places, which are hereby found to be five of the most public places in the Municipality, are hereby designated for the posting of notice of the adoption of ordinances of the Municipality:

- 1. Cherry Valley City Hall
- 2. Emergency Service Building
- 3. Cross County Bank
- 4. First National Bank
- 5. Post Office

<u>Section 2</u>. Notice of the adoption of ordinances of the Municipality shall be effected by the posting of ordinances at the locations set forth in Section 1 hereof.

<u>Section 3</u>. All other ordinances and resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 4</u>. It has been found that proper notification of the adoption of ordinances of the Municipality is essential to the governance of the Municipality. Therefore, an emergency is declared and this Ordinance, being necessary for preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall be in force upon its passage and approval.
